




Clockwise from top: friends enjoying Barcelona; Gaudi's Casa Milà; Catalan vineyard; Park Guell and the cityscape.

Enjoy a privileged visit to the Gran Teatro del Liceo, incuding entrée to the Circulo del Liceo, a private club not open to the general public, with its amazing collection of Catalan art. Lunch on Catalan cuisine in the private dining room, then, accompanied by an insightful guide, explore backstage areas.

Visit this small, vibrant region in Catalonia, just 100 miles southwest of Barcelona, and sample the house wines of internationally known Clos de l'Obac bodega; a special dinner in the owner's restaurant, Celler de Gratallops, follows.



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
