


Clockwise from top: summer evening in Split's town square; statue of bishop Gregory of Nin in Split; rare white truffles; soaking in the Adriatic views.

Blue Caves, White Truffles, Red-Hot *Thrones* 

Game of Thrones Walking Tour:

Enter the world of HBO's runaway hit, Game of Thrones, on your exclusive private tour of Dubrovnik — today best known as King's Landing, capital of the Seven Kingdoms. Ride the cable car to the top of Srd Hill for a spectacular panorama over Old Town, the Adriatic, and nearby islands. Climb the city walls while listening to tales of King Robert Baratheon and his rule over the Iron Throne. Then pass the Pile Gate and discover the fate of the exiled Targaryen family before coming to Lovrijenac Fortress for magnificent views of Blackwater Bay.

Truffle Hunting in Istria: Head out across the rugged, wonderful region of Istria with a truffle hunter and his dog as they search for the elusive white truffle. Your private car takes you to the village of Livade, one of Europe's most important truffle-farming centers. You will learn all about this magical fungus and how it is harvested while out on your hunt. Your Istrian outing also includes the ruins of medieval Motovun, the ancient hilltop town of Grožnjan, and a private wine tasting in charming Momjan.

Brijuni National Park by Private Motorboat: Join your guide for a drive to the coastal town of Fazana, where a private motorboat carries you to the uninhabited island of Veliki Brijun, the largest of the 14 islands in the Brijuni archipelago. After being developed as an exclusive resort and then used by the Yugoslavian dictator Tito as his summer residence, Brijuni was finally opened to visitors as a national park in 1983. Learn about its history while visiting the remains of a Roman villa, the archaeological museum, and more.
