To top it all off – shop in the Grand Bazaar!

**intriguing walking tour** showcases the local life and sights of the Beyoglu (Pera) district, on the European side of Istanbul. Accompanied by your private guide, you'll cross the Golden Horn via the Galata Bridge to discover wonderful vistas from Galata Tower; an opulent palace hotel; the famed Istiklal Caddesi pedestrian street ("Independence Street"); Taksim Square; and the ornate Cicek Pasaji ("Flower Passage") filled with restaurants locals frequent for delicious plates of *meze* and Kebabs.



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
