Culinary Coup: Enjoy an exclusive culinary experience with Ramón Freixa, one of Spain's most celebrated chefs, whose restaurant has been awarded two Michelin stars. Accompanied by chef Ramón, you'll visit the stalls of a local market to buy the best seasonal produce. Then, enjoy a private cooking class with Freixa in his Madrid restaurant and taste the delicious results!

A Day of Art for Children: Led by a fine arts teacher, children will visit the Prado or Reina Sofía Museums to see emblematic works by Velázquez, Gaudí and Picasso. They will then create their own works of art, to take home as souvenirs

Local Life: Castilla: Accompanied by a local resident, you'll stop first at Peñafiel, one of the region's prettiest towns, to visit Peñafiel castle.

Next: A taste of delicious sheep cheese in a visit with a local cheese maker, and then on to the López Cristóbal vineyards to sample wine. Dine on a traditional lamb roast in the medieval wine cellar of a private home, and then enjoy coffee and a digestive liquor in your guide's own house in nearby Pedrosa de Duero.
